ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 4:00 pm Wednesday, January 14, 2009 (or when building is ready). Dogs must be removed from the show site 1 hour following Best in Show judging on Monday, January 19, 2009.

THERE SHALL BE NO DRILLING NOR INTENSIVE OR CORRECTIVE TRAINING OF DOGS ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR PREMISES.

ALL DOGS shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience or agility rings.

No play huts or similar holding structures will be allowed.

All crating must be WITHIN taped and posted areas. No exercise pens in D or E Hall. Due to possible space restrictions, the show giving clubs reserve the right to require exhibitors to reduce their crating space.

This is a spectator friendly show that draws large crowds, especially on weekends. Please plan accordingly & allow yourself plenty of time to arrive to the show grounds & to the ring.

PARENTS SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CHILDREN.

NO FLEXI LEADS, HALTI TYPE COLLARS OR PINCH COLLARS IN THE BUILDING.

The show-giving clubs are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show.

THE SHOW COMMITTEES will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these shows.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

NO DOGS wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class, unless specifically allowed for in AKC Rules & Regulations.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

The Tualatin Kennel Club, Inc. & the Portland Dog Obedience Club, Inc. do not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Whippets, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs & Xoloitzcuintli. Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund)

NEW EXHIBITOR BRIEFING on Saturday. Check Judging Program for time & location.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

RETURNED CHECKS/INVALID CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check & credit/debit card. Subsequent returned checks & credit/debit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

The show giving Club, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

EXHIBITORS NOTE: Please notify Superintendent of any change of address.

All entries received with credit/debit card for payment will have a service charge added.

PARKING INFORMATION

Please carefully review the parking information below. The Rose City Classic Clubs hope you will find this information helpful in making your arrangements. Your cooperation is appreciated...



GENERAL INFORMATION

- ◆ All parking is a privilege extended by the show-giving clubs & the Portland Exposition Center. They reserve the right to withdraw this privilege from any person or persons who uses abusive language, argues with parking personnel or attempts to circumvent the rules & regulations. All parking is at your own risk. The show-giving clubs & the EXPO Center assume no responsibility or liability for damages or loss to any vehicle or its cargo.
- ◆ When Expo Parking Lot is full, exhibitors may enter to unload only but then must go park at PIR. All parking at Expo must be in a lined space or you will be ticketed/towed. All parking in private commercial lots across North Force Ave **WILL result in immediate towing!**
- ◆ Dogs are **NOT ALLOWED in any landscaped area** at the EXPO Center or the lawn & shrubs in the complex across North Force Ave or around the sidewalk area on the north side of the Expo Center. Failure to observe the rules may result in an Event Hearing. Outdoor exercise pens will be provided.
- ◆ Everyone using this facility is expected to keep & leave the area clean.
- ◆ Limited handicap parking (with a valid permit) is available for both the general & reserved parking areas. These spaces will have easy access but may be some distance from the show rings.
- ◆ **All overnight parking units must be self-contained. No dumping of gray water or sewage. There will be a pump-out service available on Sunday, January 18th, 2009 between 3:00 pm & 7:00 pm for a fee of \$33.00.**
- ◆ **There will be no access to ANY building from 11:00 pm until 6:00 am.** See general information for hours individual buildings will be open.
- ◆ All vehicles must vacate the premises no later than one hour following Best in Show Monday, January 19, 2009. No overnight parking on Tuesday, January 13, 2009.

LOADING & UNLOADING

- ◆ A supervised loading & unloading area close to the grooming area (**EAST SIDE**) will be available. No exhibitor loading & unloading will be allowed on the west side (North Force entrance) of the grooming area without previous arrangements with the parking contractor. A 20 minute time limit per vehicle will be observed to give as many exhibitors as possible access to this area.
- ◆ Unloading will begin at 4:00 pm, Wednesday, January 14, 2009. Please refer to the grooming information provided in this premium list for further information on access times.

GENERAL PARKING

- ◆ General parking is available daily. Enter from the **MAIN GATE ONLY**. The parking fee is \$7.00 per day.
- ◆ **Cars parked along North Force Ave &/or North Expo Rd will be TICKETED & TOWED.**
- ◆ Follow the signs to loading and unloading. **Then return to the general parking area.**
- ◆ **NO EXERCISE PENS, GROOMING OR OVERNIGHT PARKING IN THE GENERAL PARKING AREA.**

RESERVED PARKING

- ◆ Those with confirmed reserved RV overnight parking will enter thru the North Force Gate only. Reserved day of show parking will enter through **MAIN GATE ONLY**. Please have your reserved parking reservation prominently displayed in your front window.
- ◆ *Assignment of spaces will be made in the order of receipt of reservations.* Consideration is given to the best use of the parking spaces available. Oversized vehicles and/or combinations of vehicles will be placed with consideration of space available & keeping fire lanes open.
- ◆ **If you wish to park together, all reservation forms must indicate that request. If you are assigned a row rather than a specific space & wish to be parked next to another RV, you must show up to the grounds together. If power is requested, all RVs MUST pay for power due to limited availability of the power grid.**
- ◆ All vehicles must park as directed by the parking attendants.
- ◆ RV pumping of gray/black water tanks will be available on Sunday, January 18, 2009 between 3:00 pm & 7:00 pm. (Details will be contained in the envelope you will receive upon arrival)

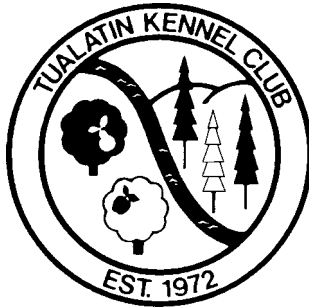

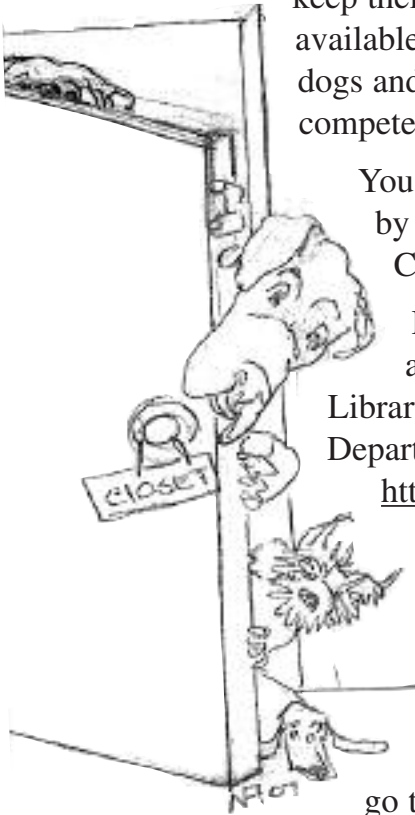
